### UNION OF GRINNELL STUDENT DINING WORKERS NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FISCAL YEAR 2019

#### NOTE 1 — DESCRIPTION OF THE ORGANIZATION

The Union of Grinnell Student Dining Workers (UGSDW) is an independent labor union based in Grinnell, Iowa. UGSDW represents student employees of Grinnell College. Every year, UGSDW negotiates a collective bargaining agreement on behalf of its workers in Dining Services. UGSDW is supported primarily through suggested monthly dues and donations.

#### NOTE 2 — SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### **Basis of Presentation**

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. UGSDW maintains its internal accounts through a general ledger. UGSDW classifies donations and assets in three categories:

Permanently Restricted — Net assets subject to donor-imposed stipulations that are required to be maintained in perpetuity.

Temporarily Restricted — Net assets subject to donor-imposed stipulations that may be satisfied through the purchase of assets or other actions of UGSDW.

*Unrestricted* — Net assets that are not subject to donor-imposed stipulations.

Unrestricted assets may be designated for specific purposes by the membership of UGSDW or by its Executive Board.

Expenses are generally reported as decreases in unrestricted net assets. Actions that UGSDW takes which satisfy requirements of temporarily restricted assets are reported as reclassification to unrestricted assets.

#### Cash and Cash Equivalents

UGSDW considers all checking accounts or accounts with online payment systems to be cash equivalents.

#### **Income Taxes**

UGSDW is a 501(c)(5) organization, and as such is exempt from federal income taxes. However, as an organization with annual gross receipts less than \$5,000, UGSDW does not have a letter of determination from the IRS for its tax exempt status.

#### **Dues and Fines Receivable**

Receivables are stated at net realizable value and are unsecured. UGSDW does not charge interest on its dues or fines receivable. UGSDW provides an allowance for doubtful accounts

using the allowance method, which is based on the Board's judgement considering historical information.

#### **Supplies and Equipment**

Supplies and equipment are stated at cost at the date of acquisition, less accumulated depreciation computed on a straight-line basis over the estimated useful life of the asset.

#### NOTE 3 — SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT

In FY 2018, UGSDW distributed buttons to its members, with the expectation that the buttons be returned. UGSDW issued fines for buttons which were not returned, and was able to collect a small portion of those fines, leading to large expenses for lost buttons and bad debts. In FY 2019, UGSDW distributed buttons to its members, but without the expectation that the buttons be returned. Buttons so distributed were classified as an "Other Action Cost" expense. In FY 2018, UGSDW also purchased buttons identifying union representatives, which are no longer used. In FY 2019, these buttons (worth \$20.00 at purchase) were written off.

#### NOTE 4 — DUES STRUCTURE

UGSDW has no mandatory dues for members. The Executive Board of UGSDW has set suggested monthly dues at \$2.00 a month, due every month except January, June, July, and August. Members working for Grinnell College Dining Services have the option of authorizing their employer to automatically deduct \$2.00 from their paychecks and send the money to UGSDW every month except January, June, July, and August, until they are no longer employed by Grinnell College Dining Services or withdraw their authorization.
